

We are committed to developing the expertise of our clinical staff. Registered nurses participate in a comprehensive six-week orientation program to ensure a successful transition to nursing excellence according to our quality standards. In addition to this initial orientation, we provide ongoing educational opportunities and support through our education department in the form of classroom learning, online learning, and hands-on guidance from excellence educators.

Continuous learning also occurs via collaboration with our expert staff of hospice-certified physicians, advanced practice nurses, and experienced RNs. We require hospice and palliative care certification of all nursing staff by the end of the third year of employment. We support that goal by providing a formal training program, paying costs associated with obtaining the certification, and providing additional financial compensation upon completion.
